Analysis: After the course was instructed, various students showed that they still have difficulties organizing a comparison or contrast paragraph using either the block or point-by-point methods. Furthermore, in terms of grammar skills, several students did not effectively use transitional words and phrases, and also punctuation marks.	1.
